Willow Park School Arts-Centred Learning Grade 7 Suggested Supply List

In Grade 7, 8 & 9, the CBE does not charge a Student Supply Fee. This means that schools do not provide student supplies and families will need to purchase student supplies. We understand that this can be a challenge for some families. If you require assistance with supplying any of the needed items, please contact the office at willowpark@cbe.ab.ca

Students are encouraged to bring essential supplies (not the full list) on the first day of school: paper, pencil crayons, pencils, and erasers.

Homeroom teachers will review specific items with their class.

The following is a list of supplies suggested for grade 7 students for the core subjects of English Language Arts, Social Studies, Math, Science, Phys. Ed., and Health. Additional supplies may be needed by students for Options classes.

It is strongly suggested that all supplies be labelled with the student's name.

#	ltem	Details
1-2	binder	Zipper binders works best especially if students struggle with organization
1	pencil case	If it can fit inside a binder even better: one less thing to lose
2-5*	packs lined paper	Grade 7's consume copious amount of paper.
2-4*	boxes of pencils	Some kids lose theirs daily, or really like the taste of them. We are still trying to figure this mystery out.
2-3*	erasers	
1-2*	pencil sharpener(s)	Remember them losing mittens when they were toddlers? Yes, sharpeners seem to grow legs and disappear often.
1	geometry set	
1	basic calculator	Nothing fancy that might need to be cleared when it gets stuck in a weird function. Students are not allowed to use their cell phones as calculators.
1	box of 24 coloured pencils	
2-4*	dry erase markers	
2-3*	fine line black marker	
1	ruler	
1	pair of scissors	
1	duotang for Health	
1-2	box of facial tissue for the class	Think 30+ kids with runny noses and only paper towel
1	Pair of athletic shoes	Students must have good athletic shoes for their safety and protection. They are not to use high soled runners, hiking shoes, 'skater' shoes, slip-ons, or flip flops for PE class.
1	Optional: Donation of box of pencils + pack of lined paper	To be added to the classroom collection for when students inevitably forget or run out.

^{**} Do not send all of these supplies to school at once. Keep some at home for when they inevitably use or lose it. It may also be wise to do a restock halfway through the year.

- Please note students are NOT allowed to have their cell phones in class

- Students should have a small container (pencil case/box, small carry bag) to carry supplies. Backpacks must be kept in lockers and not brought to classrooms. Due to time constraints, students are not to go to lockers between classes.
- Students may only have water to drink in classrooms. We suggest supplying your child with a water bottle with press dispenser operation (Not just screw on lid) that is spill proof and not glass. There is a water bottle filling station located on each floor of the school.

Physical Education classes:

Students must have good athletic shoes for their safety and protection. They are not to use high soled runners, hiking shoes, 'skater' shoes, slip-ons, or flip flops for PE class.
